How to Raise a Concern in School...

If you are worried or have a concern about any aspect of school life, you should follow the procedure below...

1. Speak with the class teacher - most often concerns can be addressed and resolved at this stage.
2. If the concern is not resolved, speak with the Principal or put your concern in writing to the Principal.
3. Following the steps above, if the concern has not been resolved, you may then write to the Board of Governors.
